Q: What is the St. Michael Parish School Annual Fund?

A: Each year, St. Michael charges less for tuition than the actual cost of educating the students. We do this in an effort to make it as affordable as possible. The Annual Fund is specifically designed to help bridge that gap. *Your tax-deductible gift pays for science equipment, library materials, athletics, music and drama programs, technology, quality faculty members, ministry programs and more.* We raise these essential funds through personal donations from parents, grandparents, alumni, friends, businesses, foundations and special events. Without these donations the cost of tuition would need to be higher or school programs would need to be cut.

Q: For budgeting purposes, can I add my Annual Fund donation to my monthly ParishPay account?

A: Yes. On the ParishPay enrollment form, there is a section for the St. Michael Parish School Annual Fund. Simply fill-out the form and return it to the parish office.

Q: If I choose not to add my Annual Fund gift to my ParishPay account, can I make the contribution via check?

A: Yes. Simply make out the check to St. Michael Parish School and write Annual Fund on the memo line. The check can then be dropped off to the school office.
